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- Discussion: City Administrator Ryan Hunt shared his concerns over the Board’s decision to set compensation for the position at pay grade 5. He explained the process used for the MARC salary study and explained that this same process has been consistently used for other City positions. The Communications Manager position could be justified as level 6, 7, or 8 according to the study. City Administrator Hunt suggested two options – 1) change the position title to Public Information Officer at a lower salary, or 2) move to grade 6 and keep the position as a Communications Manager. He also noted that for the past 3 years the City has paid \$50 per hour for a part time position.

Alderman Johnston expressed his concern that the study doesn’t justify the higher salary. He felt that Warrensburg and Harrisonville were fair comparisons to Grain Valley. He also didn’t believe there is enough demand for this to be a full time position. Alderman Stanley agreed with Alderman Johnston.

Alderman Headley reminded the Board that communication is an issue that always comes up. Citizens want to get information and without a local newspaper it can be difficult to get correct and consistent information to the public. He also questioned the level of expertise the City would find if the pay is too low.

During the vote there was a discussion with City Attorney Geary concerning Alderman Arnold’s right to vote on the ordinance since he is serving this meeting as Mayor Pro-Tem. City Attorney Geary advised that he does not give up his vote as an Alderman, and in the event of a tie, he will cast a vote as the Mayor Pro-Tem.
