- a. **Veteran's Tribute** Norm Combs and Mike Switzer
 - i. Still raising funds for an eagle statue for the site. Coordinating with Bill Bushey to install an additional flagpole.

OLD BUSINESS:

- a. Christina "Kiki" Claphan Memorial Playground Shannon Davies
 - i. The state is behind right now on formal approvals for this grant round. We should receive formal notification in April on the LWCF grant that we applied for.
 - ii. The agreement with Lamp Rynearson for design/engineering services for this project has been approved by the Board of Aldermen.

b. Football Facility Improvements – Shannon Davies

- i. Park maintenance will be installing a perimeter post-only fence made from telephone poles along the front of the park running parallel to Old 40 Hwy. They will also be installing a vehicular gate at the entrance.
- ii. This is a budgeted item for this year.

iii. This is to prevent vehicles from rutting-up our grassed areas and doing donuts in the parking lot. Once secure, park maintenance will re-level the parking lot and start repairing those grassed areas with fill dirt and seed.

a. Operational Updates

- i. Shannon Davies reported that the agreement with Lamp Rynearson for the design/engineering of the Buckner-Tarsney Trail (Nelson Drive south to Blue Branch Creek) has been approved by the Board of Aldermen. The design will be completed this year and is a budgeted item.
- ii. Shannon Davies reported that \$75,000 of American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) funds due to the City have been earmarked for a Parks Master Plan. The Grain Valley Parks & Recreation department has never had a comprehensive, master plan conducted. We plan on issuing a RFQ to qualified firms this summer and get this process started either at the end of this year or early next year.
- iii. Shannon Davies reported that we will be going over the proposed 2023-2027 Capital Improvements Program (CIP) at the next Park Board meeting.
- iv. We plan on taking our 2021 Park Board photo at next month's meeting. Shannon Davies handed-out new Park Board shirts.
