ITEM V: PUBLIC HEARING

- A request to amend Section 400.040 – Definitions and Section 400.240 – Conditional Uses of the Municipal Code of the City of Grain Valley
 - Ken Murphy and Matt Geary presented the proposed changes to Section 400.040 and Section 400.240 to regulate short-term lending establishments. Mr. Murphy stated that the purpose of having zoning codes in place is to ensure order for the greater good of the community and those short-term lending businesses are a concern because of the documented detriment to the community. summarized the changes submitted for review and approval. Bob Dimmitt asked if there is hard data that supports this. Mr. Murphy stated that there was and Mr. Geary referenced a report from Milwaukee as an example. Mike Reneau asked how we reached the distance of 1250 feet. Mr. Geary stated that it was consistent with other conditional uses already found in the code.

- Janice Brill who lives at 1035 SW Ephraim stated that she's lived here for 9 years and has been pushing the Board of Aldermen to address the issue. She stated that its clear crime goes up when short-term lending facilities enter the community and that blight also follows their arrival. She stated that she believes it's important for local government to address the issue before their power is taken away.

 - James Pycior asked for clarification on what is defined as a school. Mr. Geary stated that both public and private schools were accounted for.

Staff stated that they believed it to be possible and that the intent of the code wasn't to attempt to keep them out completely but instead to place conditions on them to ensure the well-being of the community.
 - James Pycior motioned to amend Section 400.040 – Definitions and Section 400.240 – Conditional Uses of the Municipal Code of the City of Grain Valley as presented; seconded by Craig Shelton; approved 6-0.
