A. Case V15-002: Submitted by Joe Coffman, a request for variance to setback regulations for a proposed building expansion located at 116 E Harris Street, Grain Valley, MO. The property is zoned M-1 light-industrial.

Staff gave the Board an overview of the request before them. It was stated that Coffman Custom Machine has been operating their business next door at 114 E. Harris for a number of years and recently purchased 116 E Harris to expand their business operation. Staff stated that they met with Mr. Coffman to look at the possibility of adding on to the newly purchased building. With the size of the lot there isn't much room to add on and meet setback regulations. Staff told Mr. Coffman that he would need a variance to setback regulations in order to expand the current business. M-1 setbacks are 30ft in the front, 20ft in the rear and 10ft on the side. The proposed addition is approximately 2,500 sq. ft.

Joe Panza asked the applicant if this was going to be a machine shop and was told that it would in fact be a machine shop just like what they currently have.

ITEM I: CALL TO ORDER

- The Board of Aldermen of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri, met in Special Session on June 6, 2016 at 6:10 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at Grain Valley City Hall

ITEM III: DISCUSSION

- 2016-2017 City of Grain Valley Employee Benefits
 - City Administrator Ryan Hunt opened this discussion with a brief synopsis of the health insurance plans available to the City’s employees, and explained that historically renewal rates have increased in the double-digits. This year, Blue Cross Blue Shield quoted only an 8% increase. Typically the City has changed plans from year to year based upon lowest bids, but in an effort to provide stability to employees, he chose the renewal option this year, rather than bidding out the benefits again.
 - City Administrator Hunt explained that there is inequity in the two plans available to employees. 50 employees are currently covered by the high deductible/HSA plan; 5 are covered by the PPO plan. Employees covered by PPO must pay a portion of their premium, while employees covered by high deductible are given \$100 monthly incentive into their HSA and pay no premium. He proposes paying the full premium for employee coverage for those who choose the PPO, making the total benefit to employees more equitable.
 - Hunt also shared that benefits costs for this fiscal year are well below what was budgeted, mainly due to attrition. With this savings he has looked at ways to fine-tune benefits to make them better for the employees. He proposed adding short-term disability benefits, with a 15 day exclusionary period. The benefit would cover up to day 180. He explained that in the past employees have had to rely on shared sick leave when they did not have enough time to cover an illness. The proposed plan pays 60% of the employee’s salary, and is taxable.
 - Alderman Stanley shared that she is not in favor of the proposed changes and feels that the savings realized this year should go towards something that benefits

- Alderman Johnston questioned why the insurance was not put out for bids, sharing that every contract should go out for bids annually.
- Alderman Arnold stated that he has seen this benefit offered in other places but accumulation of sick leave benefits were usually limited. Has this been considered?
- Mayor Todd noted that approval of the Resolution, as presented, does not make a change to the PPO premium contribution or add the short-term disability benefits.
