**A. Case V15-001:** Submitted by DPF Cleaning Solutions Inc., a request for variance to use requirements for a proposed cleaning facility to remove, inspect, clean and reattach Diesel Particulate Filters located at 108 E. AA Highway, Grain Valley, MO. The property is currently zoned C-1 Central Business District which does not allow for this use.

Staff gave the Board an overview of the request before them. Staff began talking with representatives from DPF last fall about possible locations in Grain Valley. A big issue was finding a building with doors tall enough to allow semi's to enter. 108 E AA Hwy meets their needs but isn't zoned properly.

Staff was concerned about whether or not all work would be conducted inside the building. DPF assured Staff that all work would be done inside.

Joe Panza asked if this was essentially a catalytic converter. Kim Roam representing DPF stated that it basically was. Mr. Panza also asked how the materials were disposed of. Mr. Roam stated that there are no mandates at this time. Mike Coon asked Mr. Roam if there were toxic fumes and Mr. Roam stated that he didn't believe so. Steve Shatto asked Staff why this was necessary since there was a truck repair place there at one time. Staff stated that they didn't know the

answer other than that it had been empty for over a year and the property isn't zoned for that type of business now.

Lance Sheffer's who owns Sheffer's Roofing just to the east of this building stated that he had no issue with the request.

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF GRAIN VALLEY & DIRECTOR  
OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT  
AND  
GRAIN VALLEY ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION**

The undersigned, Grain Valley Athletic Association, (hereinafter termed "Association"), having been determined by the City of Grain Valley and Director of Parks and Recreation (hereinafter termed "Director") to be an association or group organized and operating to fulfill a need in the City of Grain Valley and to accomplish a public purpose, is designated "primary provider" of youth, recreational sports in Grain Valley. Further, the Association is hereby given permission to use all athletic fields in Armstrong Park, Monkey Mountain Park and the Football Field Complex during the annual timeframes specified below for the purpose of conducting various youth leagues, tournaments and other athletic activities on a regularly scheduled basis in accordance with the schedule and sites appended hereto and made a part thereof:

- Spring Baseball & Softball Season – March 1-June 30 (or when the regular season concludes).
- Fall Football Season – August 1-October 31 (or when the regular season concludes).
- Fall Baseball & Softball Season – August 15-October 31 (or when the regular season begins and/or concludes).
  - The GVAA will not have access to the baseball fields at Monkey Mountain Park on Saturdays for tournaments unless previously reserved with the Director.

The Director reserves the right to schedule City activities during the agreement period so long as an officer of the Association is notified of each activity.

In consideration of the use of said playing fields and the necessary surrounding areas, the Association agrees to do the following:

1. Assemble and provide the Director copies of the scheduling for league practices, games and tournaments one week before each season begins.
2. Provide the Director with a minimum of 5-days' notice of all rescheduled games to afford the Director time to schedule staff for field preparation, stocking of restroom facilities and concessions coverage.
3. 5-Day Notice Exception: The Director will accommodate a reschedule within the 5-day window if the rescheduled game(s) is on a field that will already be prepped because of an existing game on that same date AND an already existing game during that same time of the day/evening on a separate field.
4. All reschedules or any deviation to the initial game schedule must be emailed or provided by "hard copy" to the Director to avoid any verbal miscommunication between both parties while maintaining a "paper trail" of rescheduling changes.

5. The Association shall schedule practices for only those teams registered through Association for Association leagues. Any non-Association teams shall contact the director for field availability.
6. For the baseball and softball leagues, each Association team shall be allotted up to three, 1.5-hour practices per week at no charge for field usage. Any additional practice time for an Association team must be approved by the Director.
7. The Association shall provide the Complete Practice Schedule to the Director once all Association teams have been accommodated so that the Director has the ability to reserve and sell field space for non-Association teams in the event of remaining, available field space. With any changes to the original Association Practice Schedule once the initial draft is complete, Association teams will have to go through the Director to check on field availability and to switch practice times. The Director shall provide the Association with an updated Practice Schedule anytime changes are made.
8. The Director shall not reserve any fields (except on Saturdays at Monkey Mountain Park) for any non-Association use once Association games begin to ensure that the Association has the flexibility to reschedule games as needed.
9. Each Commissioner shall provide the Director with a database denoting Team Name, Division, Head Coach Name, Head Coach Phone Number, Head Coach Email Address for that sport or activity at the beginning of each season, in the event a need arises to make contact regarding field issues and to confirm they have submitted an application for the background screening. The Director will then provide a list of coach's names to the Association that have not completed and submitted the background screening application within a timely manner in order to make contact with those coaches and assist in the process.
10. The Association is empowered by the Director to control the behavior of participants and spectators during events. The umpire/referee can eject unruly or dangerous participants, coaches, parents or spectators from the premises during the events. The Association may contact the Grain Valley Police Department on behalf of the umpire/referee if an ejected individual refuses to leave the premises.
11. The Association shall allow vehicles in Armstrong Park, Monkey Mountain Park and the Football Fields to park in designated parking areas only, unless authorized by the Director.
12. Schedule activities in assigned areas. Activity schedules must be approved by the Director.
13. It is the Director's intention that Grain Valley School District youth be accommodated before non-Grain Valley School District youth regarding registering for youth sports in Grain Valley. The Association shall ensure that all Grain Valley School District youth who have registered within the registration period set forth by the Association, are assigned to a team. The Director and Association will work together to determine league maximums based off of available athletic facilities.

14. Director must approve activities other than youth leagues and tournaments at park facilities.
15. The Director will be included in all discussion and agreements for tournaments sponsored by the Association, co-sponsored with outside groups, or sponsored in full by outside groups, outside the tournaments agreed upon by both parties at the beginning of the contract year.
16. Tournaments, leagues, or other events sponsored in conjunction with others or solely by others must be approved by the Association and the Director in advance and will require a Field Use Permit from the Director. No other group may be allowed to use the fields in their place. The permit will be completed by the Director.
17. Vendors that request to set up areas to sell food and/or merchandise, or to advertise on City of Grain Valley property must be approved in advance through the Director. This also applies to tournament sponsors that wish to sell food and/or merchandise. Vendors for Association sponsored team pictures are excluded.
18. Not change or alter park property in any way unless written consent has been granted by the Director.
19. Pay the cost of replacement or repair of any park property damaged through the proven negligence of or the act or actions of the Association and its participants and only when such negligence or actions is founded.
20. For the protection of children from sexual offenders, and per City Ordinance, the Director is requiring programs under its direction and/or using City of Grain Valley facilities to develop policies and procedures that in so far as possible protect the safety of children from sexual offenders.
  - In order to meet this requirement, the Association is required to have all coaches (volunteers) working with youth on City of Grain Valley facilities perform Missouri Division of Family Services child abuse or neglect/criminal record checks on all volunteers(coaches and/or managers, board members, concession workers, officials, etc.) 18 years of age and older.
  - The Association will work through the Director to get the background screenings conducted.
  - The Association will provide the Director with a complete list of coaches and their contact information so that the Director can cross-reference to confirm that they have completed the background screening process.
21. Will make every attempt to schedule practices/games so that play duration will not overrun the 11:00pm curfew that has been established by City Ordinance in all parks.
22. Assume the responsibility of maintaining control of their own program and take all necessary steps to prevent the violation of any City Ordinance or any act or action that might be detrimental to the City of Grain Valley.

23. The Association is responsible to insure Association property stored in or on City of Grain Valley property. The City shall have no liability for any damage to any Association property stored in or on City property.
24. The Association shall indemnify, release, become responsible for and forever hold harmless the Director and the City of Grain Valley, their respective officers, agents, employees, elected officials, and attorneys, each in their individual capacities, from and against all lawsuits, actions, costs, claims, demands, damages, disability, losses, expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees and other defense costs or liabilities (including attorneys' fees and other defense costs incurred in any action to enforce this indemnity provision), of any character and from any cause whatsoever brought because of bodily injury or death received or sustained, or loss or damage received or sustained, by any person, persons, or property arising out of or resulting from any act, error, omission, or intentional act of the Association or its agents, employees, invitees, guests or users, of the City of Grain Valley's playing fields and facilities through the contract year as herein set forth and provide Director a certificate of insurance indicating coverage naming the City of Grain Valley, Missouri as additional insured. This coverage must provide a general aggregate liability of \$2,000,000.00 to cover all operations included herein. Association shall on January of each year provide City, through the City Administrator, with a copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy. Association shall also provide immediate written notification to City of any cancellation or change in insurance coverage.
25. Association shall not place banners, signs or advertisements at City of Grain Valley facilities without approval from the Director. Team and Association name banners that do not include advertisement beyond the name of the teams sponsors are excluded and must be placed on their respective dugout/sideline only and only during the duration of their respective game.
26. It is the responsibility of the Director to determine field playability as it relates to user safety, damage to grounds, turf and/or infields at practice and game fields. However, it is required that the Director's representative notify the Association's representative prior to making the call playable or not. The Director will be responsible to repair damage caused by such use.
27. Encourage participants in their program to be responsible while using City of Grain Valley Facilities by removing any trash, debris, equipment after their practices/games. This includes dugouts/sidelines, field of play, spectator areas, and parking lots.
28. Beginning with the 2015 Football season, the Association shall compensate the City of Grain Valley in the amount of \$2.00 (two dollars) per registration for the 2015 Football season. Beginning with the 2016 Spring Baseball and Softball season, and continuing with the 2016 Football season and 2016 Fall Baseball and Softball season, and every subsequent season through the specified contract end date, the Association shall compensate the City of Grain Valley in the amount of \$5.00 (five dollars) per registrant for those activities/leagues operated by the Association that take place on City of Grain Valley facilities, to assist with the recoupment of facility usage expenses incurred by the City of Grain Valley. The

Association shall provide the City of Grain Valley an annual account of registrants for each league, each season.

- a. Payment by the Association will be made to the Director once registrations and refunds for each particular league has been completed and before games for that particular league has begun.
29. The Association shall post a Year-End, Revenue and Expense Report on their website outlining the revenues and expenses of each sport, each season that shall be generated by their auditor.
  30. The Association and the Director hereby agree that this Agreement shall not be assigned, transferred, conveyed or otherwise disposed of without the prior consent of the other party to the Agreement.
  31. The Association shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, codes and regulations.
  32. In order to provide necessary flexibility for the most effective execution of this Agreement, whenever both the Director and the Association mutually agree, changes to this Agreement will be affected by placing them in written form and incorporating them into this Agreement as an amendment, to be approved by the Board of Aldermen.
  33. It is mutually agreed that in case any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of law to be unconstitutional, illegal, or unenforceable, it is the intention of the parties that all the other provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
  34. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to its subject matter and any prior agreements, understandings, or other matters, whether oral or written, are hereby merged into and made a part hereof, and are not of further force or affect. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create an employee relationship between the Director, the City of Grain Valley, and the members, employees or agents of the Association.

### **Director Sponsored Leagues and Tournaments**

1. The Director reserves the right to reserve use of the City's fields for Director activities.
2. The Director has the authority to schedule activities on the City's athletic fields throughout the calendar year, however, while the Association's activities are in-season as referenced above, the Association's activities will serve as the primary user and no other groups shall be accommodated for until all of the Association's field-use needs have been met, per the approval of the Director.

**In consideration of said funds and services, the Director agrees to provide the following:**

1. Maintenance of all utilities.
2. Personnel and supplies for athletic field preparation for practices, games and tournaments.
  - a. The condition of City of Grain Valley athletic fields shall be reasonably cared for to ensure participant safety and field ‘playability.’
  - b. Routine maintenance and care must be provided as needed to ensure the establishment of grass prior to each season and that the fields are draining appropriately.
3. Personnel a turf management and will include:
  - a. Seed, sod, fertilizer, and pest control.
  - b. Irrigation
  - c. Aeration
4. Maintenance and repair of the restroom/concession building and fixtures except for those items owned by the Association.
5. Maintenance, repair and replacement of City of Grain Valley fencing, trees, shrubs, athletic field lighting and walkways.
6. The turning on and off of all athletic field lighting.
7. Allow the Association to use storage buildings where available.
8. Winterize restroom/concession buildings and water fountains. Timing of these activities will be based on weather and temperature conditions and will be decided on jointly between the Director and the Association.
9. Properly plan for and implement improvements to fields and facilities to accommodate growth in youth league participation in a responsible and timely manner. This will be the primary function of the Director/Association Sub-committee.

**Further Mutual Agreements and Understandings:**

1. Any Association activities conducted outside of their regular scheduled season as referenced above, shall be assessed the designated fee, per the adopted City Fee Schedule.
2. One member of the Board of Aldermen shall serve as one of the voting members on the Association’s board and will also serve as liaison between the Association and the City.

3. The Association shall maintain its 501c3 status and maintain good standing with the State of Missouri and IRS as a partner with the City and Director. The Association shall annually file their IRS 990 Filings with the City of Grain Valley. In the event the Association's 501c3 status gets revoked, the Association has 7 business days to notify the Director of the revocation.


4. In the event that the Association operates the concession stand should they decide to have concessions service available during their football season at the football field complex, the Association shall be responsible for the purchase of all concessions product being sold on-site. The Association shall also retain all proceeds. The Association shall be responsible for the appliances and equipment needed to operate the concession stand. The Association shall maintain compliance with all applicable Jackson County Health Codes for food preparation and handling, as well as compliance with provisions set forth in the Grain Valley Code of Ordinances.

5. If Association fails to perform any obligation imposed upon Association hereby, Director will give a thirty day notice to correct any such failure. In the event that the Association fails to correct any failure then the Director may terminate this agreement by delivering not less than ten (10) days written notice of termination to the Association. Upon a termination of this agreement, the Association's financial commitment to the Director as described above is terminated as well with no further payments to be made.

6. This Agreement shall be effective July 31, 2015 and the first use of the athletic fields in the parks herein identified shall be July 31, 2015 and this Agreement shall terminate on November 30, 2018 provided that the (a) the term of this Agreement shall be automatically extended for one year periods unless either party shall have given written notice of its intention of non-renewal to the other party not less than ten (10) days prior to the last day of any term.

**SECTION 1:** The City of Grain Valley's annual tax levies for 2015 shall be levied on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation of all taxable real estate, personal property, including individual and business personal property, and all locally assessed railroad and other utility real estate and personal property in the City of Grain Valley, Missouri at the following rates:

- A. General Municipal Government Operations - \$ 0.5554 for general municipal government operations to be deposited in General Fund.
- B. Retirement of General Obligation Debt - \$1.0025 for the retirement of general obligation debt, including the payment of principal and interest, to be deposited in the Debt Service Fund.
- C. Park Maintenance - \$0.1226 for park maintenance to be deposited in the Park Fund.
- D. Public Health - \$0.0489 for public health purposes to be deposited in the Public Health Fund.

Total City Levy - \$1.7294

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri legislature amended Chapter 571, RSMo, effective August 28, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri State Statute amendment changed the elements relating to carrying a concealed weapon while intoxicated; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Grain Valley, Missouri Code of Ordinances, Section 215.410 (A)3, shall be amended to reflect the guidelines of the Missouri State Statute.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 215, Section 215.410 (A)3 of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to read as the following:

**SECTION 215.410 WEAPONS – CARRYING CONCEALED – OTHER UNLAWFUL USE.**

- A. A person commits the offense of unlawful use of weapons if he/she knowingly:
1. Carries concealed upon or about his/her person a knife, a firearm, a blackjack or any other weapon readily capable of lethal use.
  2. Discharges or shoots a firearm within the City limits.
  3. Exhibits, in the presence of one or more persons, any weapon readily capable of lethal use in an angry or threatening manner; or Has a Firearm or projectile weapon capable of lethal use on his or her person, while he or she is intoxicated, and handles or otherwise uses such firearm or projectile weapon in either a negligent or unlawful manner or discharges such firearm or projectile weapon unless acting in self-defense.

4. Carries a firearm or any other weapon readily capable of lethal use into any church or place where people have assembled for worship, or into any school, or into any election precinct on any election day, or into any building owned or occupied by any agency of the Federal Government, State Government or of the City, or into any public assemblage of persons met for any lawful purpose, except as provided below.

## Chapter 215. Offenses

### Article X. Offenses Against the Public Order

#### Section 215.410. Weapons — Carrying Concealed — Other Unlawful Use.

- A. A person commits the offense of unlawful use of weapons if he/she knowingly:
1. Carries concealed upon or about his/her person a knife, a firearm, a blackjack or any other weapon readily capable of lethal use.
  2. Discharges or shoots a firearm within the City limits.
  3. ~~Possesses a firearm or projectile weapon while intoxicated.~~
  4. Carries a firearm or any other weapon readily capable of lethal use into any church or place where people have assembled for worship, or into any school, or into any election precinct on any election day, or into any building owned or occupied by any agency of the Federal Government, State Government or of the City, or into any public assemblage of persons met for any lawful purpose, except as provided below.
- B. Subparagraphs (1), (2) and (4) of Subsection **(A)** of this Section shall not apply to or affect any of the following:
1. All State, County and Municipal Law Enforcement Officers possessing the duty and power of arrest for violation of the general criminal laws of the State or for violation of ordinances of counties or municipalities of the State, or any person summoned by such officers to assist in making arrests or preserving the peace while actually engaged in assisting such officer;
  2. Wardens, superintendents and keepers of prisons, penitentiaries, jails and other institutions for the detention of persons accused or convicted of crime;
  3. Members of the Armed Forces or National Guard while performing their official duty;
  4. Those persons vested by Article **V**, Section 1 of the Constitution of Missouri with the judicial power of the State and those persons vested by Article III of the Constitution of the United States with the judicial power of the United States, the members of the Federal Judiciary;
  5. Any person whose bona fide duty is to execute process, civil or criminal;
  6. Any Federal probation officer; and
  7. Any corporate security advisor meeting the definition and fulfilling the requirements of the regulations established by the Board of Police Commissioners under Section 84.340, RSMo.
- C. Subparagraphs (1, 3 and 4) of Subsection **(A)** of this Section do not apply when the actor is

transporting such weapons in a non-functioning state or in an unloaded state when ammunition is not readily accessible or when such weapons are not readily accessible. Subparagraph (1) of Subsection **(A)** of this Section does not apply when the actor is also in possession of an exposed firearm or projectile weapon for the lawful pursuit of game, or is in his/her dwelling unit or upon business premises over which the actor has possession, authority or control, or is traveling in a continuous journey peaceably through the City.
