

## **PARKS FAQ**

**Q:** How do I reserve a picnic shelter, pavilion, or athletic field for private gatherings?

**A:** All park facility rentals are done at the Grain Valley Community Center at 713 S Main Street, or call (816) 847-6230.

**Q:** What are park hours?

**A:** 6:00am - 11:00pm

**Q:** Are animals allowed in the parks?

**A:** Yes. However, per City Ordinance, all animals must be leashed and under control by their owner at all times while on park property. No animals are allowed in or around athletic fields or playground areas.

**Q:** Can I drink alcohol on park property?

**A:** Only when an alcohol permit has been issued. All permits are paid for at the Grain Valley Community Center at 713 S Main Street, or call (816) 847-6230.

**Q:** How do I apply for a summer job with GVPR?

**A:** Every summer, the Parks and Recreation Department hires seasonal employees for Concession Stand Attendants and Park Maintenance Workers. These positions generally get posted in early February so that seasonal staff is hired on by mid-March. An employment application can be found on the City's website and at City Hall. All completed applications should be turned into City Hall.

**Q:** How do I become a volunteer in the parks?
