#### Item XIII: ELECTED OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE

- City Clerk Theresa Osenbaugh administered the Oath of Office to the following elected officials:

#### ITEM XIV: NEW BUSINESS

- Cannon Street Reconstruction
  - Mr. Arroyo gave a history of the downtown improvements as well as the nearby side streets and addressed the request to add curb and gutter to Cannon Street; a private contractor would need to be used; Front Street is the next street, according to phasing, that would be reconstructed; it would be more cost effective to reconstruct multiple streets and replace water lines at one time
  - Michael Switzer came forward to ask the Board to consider adding curbing and an approach to the 200 block of Cannon Street; Mr. Switzer is concerned about a lack of curb allowing cars to park in yards and would like to attach his driveway to the road; Alderman Totton inquired about no parking signs, however Mr. Switzer doesn't want to restrict parking completely
  - Mr. Arroyo explained the purpose of a curb is to drain storm water and the road will need to be lowered in order for a curb to be installed; Mr. Switzer voiced his concern that he was unable to attach his driveway to the road without a curb; it was clarified that a curb is not necessary for a concrete approach to tie in to the asphalt road, however, the city does not typically construct drive approaches unless it is attached to a municipal project for utility reconstruction-this is the responsibility of whomever maintains the driveway
  - Mayor Todd asked Mr. Switzer to clarify if he was asking for the City to provide a concrete approach; Mr. Switzer confirmed; Mayor Todd reaffirmed that this is not something the city would normally do and asked how far the City places approaches when part of a municipal project; Mr. Arroyo shared that when a reconstruction project occurs, the approach is usually 6 feet
  - Alderman Totton questioned if the City needed to buy the easements back from new property owners on Front Street
  - Alderman Arnold asked for staff to come back with a recommendation; Alderman Totton asked for more information on cost and expressed concern over reconstructing an Alderman's street (Cannon Street) before earlier planned phases

- Alderman Totton asked if eventually the street would need further reconstruction; Mr. Arroyo explained that in the future there are intentions for Cannon Street to be reconstructed and receive new water lines as well as sidewalks, potentially; if Cannon Street is reconstructed, it should be done in full and complete
- Mr. Hunt summed up the solutions-full reconstruction or an approach; Mr. Hunt shared it was problematic to do an approach without the reconstruction because it is difficult to justify, however, an estimate of cost can be provided
- Alderman Arnold asked for further clarification on why a curb couldn't be placed on one side; Mr. Arroyo shared more details about the street and why, from a structural standpoint, a curb cannot be placed on one side of the road onlyphotographs or Aldermen visiting the street might be helpful for further discussion
- Alderman Totton asked what to tell residents on Front street who ask her when Front Street will be reconstructed; Mayor Todd shared that a date has not been set yet; Alderman Totton reminded the Board that Front Street residents were told their road would be reconstructed next
- Mr. Arroyo will provide profile pictures and costs at a future meeting






