municipal courts ability to clear the backlog of traffic violations; April is being considered as a warrant amnesty month; minor traffic violations or similar violations would be able to be paid for without fear of being arrested; this helps clear out the backlog of traffic tickets

- Mayor Todd asked if those with tickets would have to come in to City Hall to pay; these must be taken care of in person
- Alderman Headley asked if the fines still apply; fines would need to be paid; there are multiple ways to structure a warrant amnesty including setting a new court date; the preferred way is to let violators pay the fees without a reassigned court date
- Alderman Totton asked for the severity of cases eligible; traffic citations and similar situations; guidelines can be set
- All members were in favor of moving forward with a resolution
