CONSENT AGENDA:

a. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> Motion by Norm Combs, second by Don Caslavka to approve the minutes from the March 6 meeting. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

a. REVIEW OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE/EXPENDITURES/REVENUES: Shannon highlighted and explained the more notable expenditures in the summary report including the costs of the new John Deere commercial mower, spring league baseball/softball supplies and organic soil for the community garden.

CITIZEN COMMENTS:

a. None.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **a.** Veteran's Tribute
 - i. Norm Combs stated that the Pathways of Honor committee are looking at fundraising opportunities. Specifically attending gun shows.

OLD BUSINESS:

- a. Dillingham Trail Project Shannon Davies
 - i. Park Maintenance and Public Works have graded and installed two drains to divert the standing water between the bridge and Duncan Road. The water now drains into the adjacent creek.
 - ii. The signage alerting drivers of the upcoming crosswalk over Duncan Road have been relocated to an appropriate distance. When activated, the signals at the crosswalk flash for 17 seconds.

b. Cross Creek Trail Project – Shannon Davies

- i. Shannon will be developing an RFQ for the design and engineering of the pedestrian bridge.
- ii. Brad suggested that the parks department flag the proposed route of the trail that will run parallel to Blue Branch Creek and then those park board members who are interested can walk the route and make any suggestions.

iii. Terra Technologies plans on clearing for the trail this spring, weather dependent.

c. Park Security – Shannon Davies

i. Four security cameras have been ordered for Monkey Mountain Park. These are to replace the three existing cameras that are no longer operational and then one additional camera will be added to cover the exterior of the concession stand. The cameras that cover the athletic fields will be mounted on a light pole significantly lower than the existing cameras so that they can be serviced by our own boom truck.

d. Year End Report – Shannon Davies

i. The board provided feedback on the 2017 Year End Report.

e. Park Improvements – Shannon Davies

- i. Shannon provided a price quote from local vendor Stanton Steel for three, picnic table shelters. The pricing came in considerably cheaper for having these structures fabricated here through a local steel business versus purchasing through a vendor that specializes in these structures and general park amenities. Norm Combs made a motion to purchase three picnic table shelters through Stanton Steel, and Nathan Hays seconded.
- ii. The board requested that Shannon come back with proposed locations around Butterfly Trail for these structures to be placed for approval.

f. GVSL Facility Use Agreement – Shannon Davies

- i. Shannon met with GVSL regarding Spring Flag Football. This is a new program that GVSL is offering. GVSL asked if the Park Board would waive any facility usage fees with this being its first season, similar to the fall football program last year.
- ii. Jared English made a motion to waive any facility use fees for the 2018 spring, flag football season providing that they provide financial documentation of their 2018 fall football season. Terry Hill seconded.

- Charley's Roadhouse Discussion
 - Memos were provided for the Board of Aldermen from Chief Starbuck and Mr.
 Arroyo regarding police calls and code violations; outcome of tonight's meeting will direct if the Board would like Charley's Roadhouse representatives to come for a hearing or if the process will continue only through the citation channels available
 - Chief Starbuck reviewed the memo outlining the times and types of calls received by the Police Department; Alderman Coleman asked why charges routinely were dismissed by the Court; Chief Starbuck cannot speak to the dismissal as he is not present at the Court proceedings; City Attorney Jim Cook does not recall the charges being dismissed and asked for information about upcoming citations; Alderman Arnold asked for more information regarding the time period between citations; citizens shared they stopped filing complaints when they felt no progress was being made
 - Autumn Chambers and Rose McLaughlin, Grain Valley residents, passed out photos, including photos with nudity, posted on Charley's Roadhouse Facebook page; residents shared concerns regarding noise and safety concerns as they felt they were being intimidated
 - Alderman Totton shared that she has seen the establishment support charitable events; residents were aware of these issues but didn't feel they were respectful of residents of Grain Valley; Alderman Totton felt the bar was there before many of the houses and that should be considered
 - Alderman Bamman asked if anyone from Charley's Roadhouse was present tonight; the purpose of the discussion tonight is to review the executive summary and decide if a public hearing or revocation hearing is needed; Alderman Bamman would like to have a hearing; City Clerk Osenbaugh read from the

Municipal Code which stated that licensees shall be given no less than 10 days notice to appear before the Board of Aldermen; a motion from the Board to notify Charley's to appear will be needed

- Mayor Todd thought the establishment has hired legal representation and a public hearing was a consideration; Alderman Headley asked if there were consequences if representatives do not show for a public hearing; no consequences would be given; Alderman Bamman asked what would be the precedent for taking a less formal route than going through the formal revocation process; advantage is to figure out the facts and see how strong of a case is present but if the ordinance violations continue they will need to be seen in Municipal Court and in front of the Board of Aldermen; there is no reason not to move forward with the administrative hearing
- Mayor Todd asked for clarification about the conflict of interest; Alderman West may have a conflict; Mr. Cook shared that Alderman West can abstain from the vote if she feels a conflict might be perceived but this doesn't mean that this is a legal conflict of interest
- Alderman Bamman would be fine with moving to the formal process; Mr. Hunt would like it to occur outside of the next Board meeting as new officials are being sworn in; staff will reach out to everyone to find out what dates will work best
- Alderman Bamman made a Motion to set an administrative hearing before the Board of Aldermen regarding revocation or suspension of the liquor license for Charley's Roadhouse at a date to be determined by the Board of Aldermen

ITEM XI: PRESENTATIONS

- 2018-2019 Benefits Rates Presentation
 - Ms. Khalilah Holland, Executive Administrative Assistant, passed out and reviewed the rates from Midwest Public Risk for insurance costs for 2018-2019; overall increase for MPR health insurance was 9.6%; City increases will be at or below overall increase; Board had budgeted a 5% increase for 2018 and rates are above that, however, open positions have allowed the City to stay on track for the budget due to lower expenditures to this point
 - o Alderman Headley asked if there were any changes to the plans; plans will remain the same
 - o Mr. Hunt reminded the Board that in the past the goal was to get the dependent amount of paid coverage up to approximately 75%; no increase to that coverage is being currently recommended as an RFP has been put out for comprehensive benefit and fringe study and any changes in the City's portion could take place on January after that study is completed
- Grain Valley Reemployment Assistance Program
 - With the impact of the Grain Valley Market closing, a plan to help employees was brought forward; Mr. Hunt presented an overall program to help businesses in Grain Valley who have experienced a closure or significant layoff; City could serve as a central source to residents for connection to resources already in place including unemployment compensation, Grain Valley Assistance Council, local resources, etc.; metrics will need to be set by the Board of Aldermen for moving forward
 - o Mr. Hunt reviewed businesses within the City Limits; 27 businesses have 20 employees or more; Board of Aldermen will need to set the direction for how many employees a business should have in order to qualify for the program; program would go into effect when employees lose their job; utility billing deferment isn't costing the City money as it is just extending the time to pay a bill

- and offering of a payment plan; Mr. Hunt asked if there was interest in the program and the Board confirmed
- O Mr. Hunt asked for the Board to set the minimum number of employees that this program should be tied too, starting the discussion at 20 or more employees; Alderman Coleman asked about businesses with less than 20 employees; over 270 businesses are within the City limits but majority are smaller; some business have a hub in Grain Valley but not all employees are located in Grain Valley
- Alderman Headley asked if businesses with 20-75 employees could be looked at as business with corporate backing might have more resources available for employees who are laid off; 21 employers would be eligible in this range
- Tonight provides framework to come back with presentation for approval at a future meeting; utility billing deferment would be for full time employee or a part time employee with a single source of income; utility billing account would go into deferment for 90 days-all charges would be incurred but they would not be required to pay or have late fees assessed on amount; 20% overall discount would be given and a 6 month repayment plan would be set up
- Owner of current business which has closed has been reached and a roster of employees has been received; City has requested they provide information to their employees as well; Missouri Workforce Development will be utilized; workstation can be set up at City Hall or a partner station at the library; Grain Valley School District has offered to provide workshops
- Alderman West asked for details about the staff who will work with employees and coordinate the program; other organizations will be assisting with resume help and classes, etc.
- o Alderman Headley thanked the team for putting these ideas together
- Mayor has asked how many have reached out for the program; no one has reached out yet


