**Bill No. B18-23:** An Ordinance by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri Authorizing the City Administrator to Establish the 2019 Full-Time and Part-Time Pay Scale

City Attorney Jim Cook read **Bill No. B18-23** for its second reading by title only

  - City Administrator Hunt would like time to make adjustments to the presented scale and shared concerns of adopting a new scale with no implementation plan for current employees, adding to compression concerns; suggested tabling the second read of Ordinance until implementation is finalized
  - Alderman West asked for the employee exit rate; 25-30% of employees leave each year. City Administrator Hunt provided the exit interview policy; data is being analyzed to see if this is specific to certain departments

Alderman Totton asked if this included those who have been let go; this is total separation within the last two years including part-time employees
