• Mr. Trosen spoke on behalf of Capital Paving and Construction Materials; A4 Holdings LLC is the owner of the property; they have requested to use this location in 2021 for several MODOT projects in the area; they would begin work in May 2021 and conclude in November 2021; at that time, they will remove the portable plant; this will be equivalent to 3 years of truck traffic in the 7 months of work; proper notice was provided in the Examiner, Planning and Zoning Commission voted 5-2 for this plant with 8 conditions on the ordinance that will be presented tonight

- Mayor Johnston asked about the review of the condition of the road; asked if road conditions (not just visual inspection) will be performed before and after; Mr. Trosen stated that would be the purpose of the bond and it would rely on the professional opinion of the City's staff and they would rely on the study done within the last two years as well to assess prior condition
- Alderman Knox asked when the repairs would be made if needed; Mr. Trosen stated it would be done while the plant is still there; Staff does not recommend approval of this Conditional Use Permit; this type of use is allowed via conditional use permit and this is to determine if this is the right location for it
- Alderman Headley asked if there were any conversations regarding smells that would come from the plants and trucks in that area; Mr. Trosen stated there were discussions during the planning and zoning commission
- Brandon Reed; Capital Paving and Construction Materials; he responded to the smell questions regarding the plants; and there have been concerns in the past and he feels that smell is a personal opinion as to how bad it was; Alderman Headley estimated 10.4 trucks an hour as it will be running by residences and the intersections in that area when the plant is in operation; Mr. Reed stated the numbers provided were for peak operation and felt the calculation Alderman Headley estimated would be a little off as the overnight traffic is not at full operation at all times
- Alderman Knox worries about the roads in that area as they would deteriorate rapidly
- Mayor Johnston asked if there would be enough noise that would disturb residents; Mr. Reed stated it wouldn't be louder than I-70 noise
- Mr. Reed was asked to state what the benefit to Grain Valley would be of this plant being located in Grain Valley; Mr. Reed stated they pick cost effective locations for MODOT; and he doesn't know if there is a direct benefit, but it would be the most cost-effective roads for this area
- Alderman Bass asked where the projects will be
  - -Mayor Johnston opened the floor to citizens for comment at 7:30 pm-
- Cindy Bell; suggested that if the projects were that far away, there should be another location for the plant
