#### Board of Aldermen Meeting Minutes Regular Session

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- Alderman Mills moved to accept the first reading of Bill No. B22-28 and bring it back for a second reading by title only
- The Motion was Seconded by Alderman Knox
  - Mr. Murphy stated the census took place in 2020 and last ward adjustment was in 2004; the census provided where the population resides in Grain Valley; by statute, the wards should be made as even as possible by population with the largest and smallest wards within 10% of each other; Current: Ward 1 4,840 Ward 2 3,981, Ward 3 6,806 a lot of the growth has been in Ward III in recent years; the GIS person used the 2020 population to propose new boundaries; A map was provided showing the proposed updates with the proposed change Ward 1 would be at 33.6% Ward 2 would be at 35% and Ward 3 would be 31.4%-knowing there has been new construction since the census
  - Alderman Arnold feels more than just population should be considered; he provided data of registered voters from JCEB from 2016-present –he feels schools and commercial property are represented in Ward 2 and reduce the number of voters in those areas and thinks Ward 2 needs more representation
  - Mr. Murphy stated all of Valley Hills would join Ward 2 and the area around Sni-A-Bar - Alderman Arnold wouldn't like the piece going to Ward I to leave Ward II; Alderman Skinner clarified the law takes into account population, but not registered voters
  - Mayor Todd asked for the proposed ward percentages
  - Alderman Cleaver stated this is up to the citizens to vote and with the changes
     Ward 2 would have a 35% representation
  - Alderman Arnold felt it is something that should be taken into consideration if the board was interested



# AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GRAIN VALLEY, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION 105.060 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING WARD BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, Section 79.060, RSMo requires the Board of Aldermen ("Board") of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri ("City"), by ordinance, to divide the City into not less than two wards, with two aldermen elected from each ward; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Federal Law, including the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and the Voting Rights Act, the City's wards must have substantial equality of population, which has been interpreted to mean not more than ten percent (10%) deviation between the largest and smallest ward, based on population data from each decennial U.S. Census of Population ("Census"); and

**WHEREAS,** the last redistricting of the City's wards occurred by passage of Ordinance No. 1680 on September 27, 2004; and

WHEREAS, population data from the 2020 Census has been received and analyzed; and

**WHEREAS,** based on the 2020 Census, the current population of the City's existing three (3) wards, is: Ward 1 – 4,840; Ward 2 – 3,981; Ward 3 – 6,806; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Aldermen now desires to amend Section 105.060 of the Municipal Code to outline new ward boundaries.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 105.060 of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed and replaced with a new section to read as follows:

#### Section 105.060. Wards.

A. Ward One. This voting area would include the entire area bound by the intersection of Minter Road and AA Highway (SW Eagles Parkway), east to Sni-A-Bar Boulevard (SAB), continuing southeast along SAB approximately 3,000 feet to the general center of the Farmington Lake parcel then north easterly along the center of Farmington Lake to the center line of Blue Branch

creek, then easterly along that center line to Buckner-Tarsney Road, South along Buckner-Tarsney Road to the intersection of Buckner-Tarsney Road and Ryan Road, west along Ryan Road to include property inside of Grain Valley (City) City limits south of Ryan Road (see boundary map on file with City Clerk), continuing west along Ryan Road to the intersection of Ryan Road and Minter Road, north along Minter Road to include property inside of Grain Valley (City) City limits west of Minter Road (see boundary map on file with City Clerk) and close at the intersection of Minter Road and AA Highway (SW Eagles Parkway).

- B. Ward Two. This voting area would include the entire area bound by the intersection of AA Highway (SW Eagles Parkway) and SAB, west along AA Highway, to include property inside of Grain Valley (City) City limits south of AA Highway to the west City boundary as indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, north along west City boundary to U.S. 40 Highway, east along U.S. 40 Highway approximately 2,000 feet, north approximately 1,400 feet, east to Barr Road, north to the intersection of Barr Road and R.D. Mize Rd, west to the west City boundary as indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, north to U.S. Interstate 70, follow U.S. Interstate 70 east to the eastern City boundary as indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, south along eastern City boundary as indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, west along City boundary as indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk to Old U.S. 40 Highway, west along Old U.S. 40 Highway to include property inside of Grain Valley (City) City limits south of Old U.S. 40 Highway (see boundary map on file with City Clerk) to the intersection of Old U.S. 40 Highway and Buckner-Tarsney Road, south to Blue Branch Creek, southwest along centerline of Blue Branch Creek to center of Farmington Lake, southwest along center of Farmington Lake to SAB, northwest along SAB to close at intersection of SAB and AA Highway (SW Eagles Parkway).
- C. Ward Three. This voting area would include the entire area bound by the intersection of Tyer Road and NW Jefferson Street, south to U.S. Interstate 70, east along said interstate to east City boundary indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, north along east City boundary, west along City boundary, south along City boundary all indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk to U.S. Interstate 70, west along U.S. Interstate 70 to City boundary indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk, north along same City boundary, then west along City boundary indicated in the illustration on file with City Clerk to Seymour Road, north along Seymour Rd approximately 2,000 feet, west to east boundary of Greystone Estates development, north along said east boundary line to north boundary line of Hoot Owl Estates development, west to Buckner-Tarsney Road, north to intersection of Buckner-Tarsney Road and Duncan Road, west along Duncan Road to intersection of Rust Rd to include property inside Grain Valley (City) City limits north of Duncan Road (see

boundary map on file with City Clerk), north along Rust road to north boundary line of Willow Key Estates development, west along said north boundary line to east boundary line of Rosewood Hills development, north along east boundary line of Rosewood Hills development to north boundary line of Rosewood Hills development, west along said north boundary line to Dillingham Road, south along Dillingham Road to north boundary line of Whispering Park development, west along said north boundary line to west boundary line of Whispering Park development, south to Duncan Road to include property inside Grain Valley (City) City limits north of Duncan Road (see boundary map on file with City Clerk), east on Duncan Road to west boundary of Woodbury Estates development, south along said west boundary to north boundary of Eagle Ridge Estates development, west along said north boundary to Tyer Road, south on Tyer Road to close at Tyer Road and NW Jefferson Road.

SECTION 2:	The ward lines as described and designated in Section 1 above are depicted on the map attached to and made a part hereof, marked "Exhibit A."		
SECTION 3:	That should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.		
SECTION 4:	That all existing ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.		
SECTION 5:	That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Board of Aldermen.



# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 400.460 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRAIN VALLEY, MISSOURI, TO CHANGE THE PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE DOWTOWN OVERLAY DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri and Section 400.330 of the City Code for the City of Grain Valley ("City"), the City's Planning and Zoning Commission has made a recommendation to the Board of Aldermen to amend the City Code to modify the parking regulations in the Downtown Overlay District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has the authority to implement said recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission through its power pursuant to Section 89.020 RSMo; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Aldermen finds that the amendments within said recommendation will foster further economic development and improve the general welfare for the citizens of the city.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GRAIN VALLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Section 400.460(G) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

- G. Parking Regulations.
  - Objective. To ensure that parking does not appear as the dominant element in downtown Grain Valley, is designed in keeping with the Main Street corridor and adjacent neighborhoods plan, and to provide safe, convenient access to and within sites without diminishing quality pedestrian walking or visual experiences.
  - 2. Standards. The downtown overlay district will be subject to Section 400.290, Off-Street Parking And Loading Regulations, with the additional following regulations, except that subsections (a) and (b) below shall not apply to the Transition Zone or to that portion of the Downtown Zone which lies south of Harris Street.
    - a. Parking shall not be located between a building and the street. Exceptions may be made for one (1) row of on-street parallel parking.
    - b. Parking shall be either to the side of a building or to the rear. Parking shall not be located at intersections.



WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri held a public hearing at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, to hear public comments on the proposed changes to Chapter 400, Section 400.460.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GRAIN VALLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri, hereby recommends that Section 400.460(G) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

- G. Parking Regulations.
  - 1. Objective. To ensure that parking does not appear as the dominant element in downtown Grain Valley, is designed in keeping with the Main Street corridor and adjacent neighborhoods plan, and to provide safe, convenient access to and within sites without diminishing quality pedestrian walking or visual experiences.
  - 2. Standards. The downtown overlay district will be subject to Section 400.290, Off-Street Parking And Loading Regulations, with the additional following regulations, except that subsections (a) and (b) below shall not apply to the Transition Zone or to that portion of the Downtown Zone which lies south of Harris Street.
    - a. Parking shall not be located between a building and the street. Exceptions may be made for one (1) row of on-street parallel parking.
    - b. Parking shall be either to the side of a building or to the rear. Parking lots shall not be located at intersections.

- c. Restricting vehicular and pedestrian access between adjoining parking lots at the same grade is prohibited.
- d. Vehicle entrances to parking lots are encouraged to be placed along side streets.
- e. Curb cuts shall be no wider than thirty-six (36) feet.
- f. Parking lots shall not be placed so as to create a "missing tooth" effect in a block face along Main Street.
- g. Shared parking may be allowed if the applicant prepares a study following the procedures of the Urban Land Institute Shared Parking Report, ITE Shared Parking Guidelines or other approved procedures.
- h. A formal parking study may be waived for small developments where there is established experience with the land use mix and its impact is expected to be minimal.
- i. Payment In-Lieu-Of Parking. In lieu of providing the required parking spaces, a developer may pay the City a sum of money equal to the cost of a surface parking stall, that is the product of the number of parking spaces required but not provided.
  - (1) The funds collected by the City will be used by the City to acquire and/or develop on-street or off-street parking and related facilities which are determined by the Board of Aldermen to alleviate the need for parking spaces in the downtown area.
  - (2) The cost of a surface parking stall shall be established by the City and subject to review on a yearly basis.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its execution by the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Grain Valley, Missouri.

#### **BOA STAFF REPORT**

Chapter 400 – Zoning Regulation Amendment – Section 400.460 October 24, 2022

#### **ACTION:**

Requesting the approval of amendment to Chapter 400 on the Zoning Regulations regarding Section 400.460 (Downtown Overlay District) - parking regulations.

#### **ANAYLSIS:**

The amendment to Chapter 400, Zoning Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances, Section 400.460 - Downtown Overlay District would allow two regulations be exempt in the Transition Zone and that portion of the Downtown Zone which lies south of Harris Street.

The two regulations that would be waived and therefore allow parking between the building and the street and parking lots at the intersections.

The Board of Aldermen initiated this amendment and sent it to the Planning and Zoning Commission for consideration. The city owns three vacant parcels that are south of Harris Street on the east side of Main Street. The city has entertained the idea of selling these parcels. The developed property to the north and south of these parcels have parking lots that are between the building and the street. This amendment would foster economic development for this area.

#### PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION:

The Commission conducted a public hearing on September 14, 2022. The Commission approved Resolution 2022-06 recommending approval to the Board of Aldermen to amend Section 400.460 and provide for the exemption.
