

# Butterfly Park and Trail

Located between RD Mize and Highway 40, with main trailhead at NW Long Drive & Valley Woods Drive.

Open daily for walking, jogging, biking, and fishing.

Butterfly Park is a beautiful, open park with an asphalt trail surrounding a lake. The trail is accessible from the Southeast at the intersection of Highway 40 and OOIDA Drive, or on the West side at the intersection of NW Long Drive and Valley Woods Drive. Along the trail there are small picnic shelters for public use. Fishing is permitted. Leashed dogs/cats are allowed and must be under control while on the trail.

**Park includes:**

- 0.8-mile figure-eight asphalt trail
- 10-acre lake with fishing
- Legacy Plaza
- Parking lot
- Picnic shelters with tables
- Restrooms and water fountains

Butterfly Park is also home to the Veteran’s Tribute at Legacy Plaza, which honors all living and fallen veterans who answered the call to serve our country.
