

Clover “Pocket Park”

Clover Park is a small “green space” in southern Grain Valley in the Abar subdivision. The entrance to the park is a sidewalk at the intersection of SW Brome Drive and Clover Drive.

This park is for public use and cannot be reserved.

Leashed dogs/cats are allowed at the park but not on any playground areas.

Clover Pocket Park includes:

- Swing sets
- BBQ grill
- Picnic tables
- Benches

(NO electricity, NO parking, NO restrooms)

“Pocket Parks” are small open areas in the middle of housing developments that are donated to the city for use as a public park. Because many residences are adjacent to these parks, please be respectful when visiting by keeping noise at a reasonable level and picking up any trash when you leave.
