

Eagle “Pocket Park”

Eagle Park is a small “green space” in central Grain Valley in the South Willow Gardens subdivision. The nearest street intersection is Broadway St & NW Garden St. There are two entrances to the park: a sidewalk between houses on the east side off NW Garden Street, and another on the south side off Broadway Street.

This park is for public use and cannot be reserved.

Leashed dogs/cats are allowed at the park but not on any playground areas.

Eagle Park includes:

- BBQ grill
- Picnic tables
- Bench

(NO electricity, NO parking, NO restrooms)

“Pocket Parks” are small open areas in the middle of housing developments that are donated to the city for use as a public park. Because many residences are adjacent to these parks, please be respectful when visiting by keeping noise at a reasonable level and picking up any trash when you leave.
