

Farmington Meadows “Pocket Park”

Farmington Meadows Park is a lake within the Farmington Meadows subdivision. The intersection of SW Sni-A-Bar Blvd & SW Lakeview Drive is near the southwest end of the lake. The easiest access to the lake is by the Blue Branch Creek Trail. Street parking is available on the west side of the lake along SW Laura Lane, or on the east side in the Blue Branch Creek Trail parking lot at the end of SW Cross Creek Drive.

This park is for public use and cannot be reserved.

Leashed dogs/cats are allowed at the park.

Farmington Meadows Park allows fishing but includes no other amenities. (NO electricity, NO shelters, NO restrooms)

“Pocket Parks” are small open areas in the middle of housing developments that are donated to the city for use as a public park. Because many residences are adjacent to these parks, please be respectful when visiting by keeping noise at a reasonable level and picking up any trash when you leave.
